

Welcome to our activities programme for January to March 2025. Open Country is a Yorkshire based charity that helps people with disabilities access and enjoy the countryside.

We run 4 groups a week aimed at adults with learning disabilities or autism. These groups run between 10am-4pm and are chargeable day services:

NATURE FORCE GROUP

Every Tuesday we carry out important nature tasks around the district like tree and wildflower planting.

TRAILBLAZER GROUP

Join in with helping make our district more accessible with path improvement, cutting back vegetation and conservation projects, every Wednesday.

WILD WALKERS

Every Thursday we walk between 3-6 miles with lots of stops for nature study and to admire the views!

WILD THINGS

Every Friday we spend time down at our polytunnel growing wildflowers and wood working, or visiting open gardens and nature reserves.

ADAPTED CYCLING

Our Tandem Club runs between early April to mid October on Wednesday evenings. Please see Adventure Club on Saturday 29 March for our first Tandem activity of 2025.

WEEKEND OUTINGS, ADVENTURE CLUB, SCOOTER SOCIAL & WILD ABOUT WATER

Open first to anyone with a physical disability or sensory impairment, the outings visit a wide variety of wheelchair accessible locations.

There's a £10 booking fee for the trips and we have a wheelchair accessible minibus to get you there. We pick up from local homes, Wakefield bus station, Wakefield Westgate train station or Thornes Park.

We've chosen destinations with accessible toilets and a café, but please bring a packed lunch and a flask just in case the café's closed.

BOLTON ABBEY
